# Leadership Responsibilities

#### **Clear Falls High School Band**

Student Leadership Responsibilities

#### **Drum Majors**

- Be positive, effective role models for all band students on and off the field
- Read and understand all advice, duties, etc. as listed in the Band Handbook
- Conduct the band as required
- Maintain discipline as needed; includes band hall, practice field, bus travel, and stadium behavior.
- Assist in marching instruction as needed
- Maintain the water break system (every 10 minutes)
- Oversee all aspects of the band traveling including inspections, meals, bus loading and role check on buses
- Drum majors must be knowledgeable of the schedule for each travel day and are responsible for the band leaving on time
- Regularly check up on, help and encourage all members of the secondary marchers
- Create Schedule for leadership exchange at football games
- Assist staff in enforcing dress code
- A Drum Major will give a "Student Report" at one fall and one spring band booster meeting
- Manage assigned areas as needed by the band staff
- Numerous other responsibilities as assigned by the band directors
- Support and assist the band directors in the performance of their duties
- Support other leaders, band directors, and all band students *at all times*
- Coordinate and communicate the meal clean up plans to the section leaders

#### **Woodwind/Brass Captains**

- Be positive, effective role models for all band students on and off the field
- Maintain discipline as needed; includes band hall, practice field, bus travel, and stadium behavior
- Assist drum majors in all aspects of traveling; lining up when off of the buses at games and competitions
- Study and know the drill for your area of the field
- Assist with marching instruction as needed
- Be alert for instructions at all times in all venues
- Create "Aerobics Mix" for Summer Band and set up iPod, cords, etc. prior to rehearsal
- Work to stay informed of day to day performance goals and operations
- When called upon, Captains will be the only leaders to give instruction during large ensemble rehearsals
- Regularly help and encourage all members of the secondary marching block
- Communicate with and encourage all students sitting out during rehearsals
- Communicate regularly with Section Leaders to assist them as needed

- Assign and organize all student lockers
- Complete a weekly inspection of lockers by section
- Assist with assignment, organization and record keeping of inventory
- Assist with December Inventory Check with Mr. Zavalla
- Assist on District Inventory Day at the end of May (Captains only)
- Numerous other responsibilities as assigned by the band directors
- Support and assist the drum majors in the performance of their duties
- Support other leaders, band directors, and all band students at all times

## **Section Leaders**

- Organize a section party prior to the first football game (Pre-Approved by Directors, No Hazing)
- Organize small gifts for middle school students on Middle School Night
- Develop a communication tree for your sections to disseminate information quickly
- Create a social media platform for your section where you can post reminders, announcements, etc.
- Develop relationships with students and students in your sections at BI, LCI, and SI.
- Create Section Basket for the Silent Auction at Spring Concert
- Be the musical leaders in your section
- Ensure organization of instruments/equipment in rehearsal, out of rehearsal, and make sure all instruments are in working order BEFORE or AFTER rehearsal.
- Work to create a "culture" within your section.....what does that look like?
- Responsible for organization and dissemination of drill cards
- Report attendance to assigned drum major
- Performance Inspections
  - Music Inspection (Musicians Only) Prior to each performance the section leader will view each member's flip folder to ensure all music is present. (Flip folders will not be used for contests.)
  - Equipment Inspection (Guard leaders need to create a check off list) Prior to each performance the section leader will view the following items from each member:
- Music Lyre (Football Games Only)
- Water Jug
- Uniform
- Band Performance Shirt to be worn during pre-performance rehearsal
- Gloves
- Gauntlets
- Shako
- Jacket
- Pants
- Band Shorts
- Shoes

- Black Socks
- Instrument Inspection (Musicians Only)
- Clean and polished
- All parts present (reeds, mouthpieces, etc)
- No major damage....please advise Mr. Zavalla on any new damage found
- How to do all this?
- Assign a specific place to inspect your section
- Allow plenty of time for the inspections
- Deficiencies
- Uniform related should be sent to a Captain
- Equipment related should be sent to Mr. Moreno
- All others should be sent to Mr. Zavalla
- Be positive, effective role models for all band students
- Study and know the drill for your area of the field
- Assist in marching instruction as needed
- Have all necessary equipment at each rehearsal
- Create and place section posters in the band hall
- Assist in maintaining field discipline
- Be alert for instructions at all time in all venues

### **Social Officers**

#### **Social Officers (general)**

- Plan all aspects of social events
- Social Event Expectations:
  - Leadership Camp Party
  - o "I Survived Summer Band" Party (Lock In)
  - o Assist section leaders with ideas for small "welcome gifts" for Intermediate Night
  - Winter Break Party
  - Spring Social Events
  - Ensure that during the spring, all section leaders have a section party that includes incoming 8<sup>th</sup> graders
- Communicate all party plans with assigned chaperones
- Schedule all social events by first day of school
- Plan and organize community service efforts
- Social officers are highly encouraged to plan and schedule more activities outside of the required events
- Communicate to the Band Members and Staff regarding social events.
- Develop and coordinate all aspects of a Freshman Buddy System.

#### Social officers are to follow the guidelines above and including:

#### **President**

- Plan and schedule MONTHLY social officer meetings.
- Create an academic tutoring list for the Band Program
- Coordinate with directors on location/set up of officer meetings
- Clearly understand all roles and responsibilities of social officer positions to help ensure that all students are handling responsibilities correctly
- Plan and coordinate all aspects of the Band Banquet
- Plan a meeting with boosters by October 1 to discuss plans of location and cost of banquet
- Coordinate with directors and band parents for any help needed for approvals, set-up, etc. for band banquet
- Create/edit a document to be passed from president to president providing all necessary information for organizing the band banquet

#### Vice-President

- Assist the President in the performance of duties
- Attend all MONTHLY social officer meetings
- Appoint and train a student library staff; there must be at least one representative of each band class on the library staff
- Ensure librarians are completing assigned projects
- Work together with directors to add all new music into the charms catalog system
- Maintain copy room operations
- Communicate with band staff regularly
- Create "College" bulletin board outside the band office including all mailings received concerning college band camps, scholarship programs, etc.
- Maintain the trophies on the lockers inside the Band Hall

#### Historians (2)

- Attend the MONTHLY officer meetings
- Coordinate with Mr. Moreno weekly during marching season to send the "Band Member of the Week" to the local newspapers/media.
- Keep record of lockers to assist students in locker trouble
- Assist Mr. Valdez with locker clean out/check out at the end of the year
- Have a camera at all band events beginning with leadership camp to have an accurate pictorial record of the year
- Appoint 2 other photographers who have the necessary skills and equipment to take quality photos throughout the duration of the year
- Create a high-quality video to be presented at the band banquet including some sort of special senior recognition

#### **Public Relations**

- Attend all MONTHLY officer meetings
- Represent the Band for the GSL portion of the football games.
- Contact head officers from other organizations for school involved opportunities.
- Organize leadership exchange lists with Drum Majors
- Keep band informed with events for other organizations on our campus and other bands in CCISD. (concerts, contests, etc.)
- Organizes and manages the Color Guard floor crew for all contests composed of band students.
- Be positive, effective role models for all band students
- Make "good luck" signs for other CFHS Fine Arts organizations and middle school bands

#### Freshman Representative

- Help coordinate and assist directors with Intermediate night
- Attend MONTHLY social officer meetings about band social events
- Keep section leaders/captains aware of problems that freshmen members may be having
- Manage assigned areas as needed by the band staff
- Numerous other responsibilities as assigned by the band directors
- Support and assist the band directors in the performance of their duties
- Support other leaders, band directors, and all band students at all times

**Special Honors Calculation Form** – Each candidate will complete the attached special honors form.

**Teacher Recommendation Form –** Please select a reference and have them complete the "Recommendation Form." These forms should be **returned to Mr. Moreno**, not the candidate.

**Peer Evaluation Forms** – You must have five peers complete the "Peer Evaluation Form." **Band Members** must include one Woodwind Player, one Brass Player, one Percussionist, one Guard Member and one Senior Leader (for returning leadership evaluation must be from a senior Drum Major or Captain). **Knights Guard** must include three guard members, one Band Member, and one Senior Leader (any section; for returning leadership evaluation must be from a senior leader). Peer evaluations must be **returned to Mr. Moreno**, not the candidate.
