Re: Band Camp!

Greetings! We hope this email finds you having a great summer. We are almost ready to get cranking with an amazing season. Please see the following information including some REQUIRED materials that need to be taken care of before students can participate on July 31st:

1. By district policy and state law students are required to have a physical on file BEFORE they can participate in the guard rehearsals. Physicals must be uploaded by the parent into RANKONE before July 31st. If your insurance for a physical take you past the 31st, they can go to a local Nurse Practitioner to fill one out and get cleared until the student's doctor is available.
2. We start on July 31st at 7 am to 6:30 pm (Monday-Thursday). Lunch time is noon-1:00 pm. Students can leave campus for lunch; however, we ask that all laws are followed regarding students under 18 having other students in the vehicle. We strongly encourage incoming 9th grade students to not ride to and from lunches with any students that drive. Students can bring a lunch, or they can have a parent pick them up.
3. Please have your student hydrate lots this week! The band and guard will spend much time outside; we will keep it during the cooler hours of the morning. However, when a student experiences dehydration symptom is usually because of lack of water from 4 days before.
4. Students spend time this week stretching and getting acclimated to the heat!
5. Students MUST have a ½ gallon jug of water for every rehearsal. Students who do not have their water, will be sent home due to health and safety protocols. We do not have water we can supply daily. The type, color, etc. of jug does not matter to us.
6. Students are to wear attire that is proper for dance maneuvering but must comply with CCISD Dress Code. This includes lace able tennis shoes for rehearsals. NO CROCS or FLIP FLOPS are allowed.
7. Students will be issued a flag on the first day. If you have one from before, please bring it with you.
8. Saturday July 29th will be when we do our Equipment Day! This is where the students can order all necessary items (lists will be sent out later this week) and be fit for their band uniform. This event and orders MUST be taken at this event to ensure we will have everything by the times/dates needed. We will stagger times for students to come in to give us a chance to spread out a little. Incoming Seniors will be from 9-10 am, Juniors from 10-11 am, Sophomores 11-noon, and 9th graders noon-1 pm. Payments in full are due by then, however, if you need a payment plan, we will have a director on site to help set that up. This will be held at CFHS, please park in the center or right side (if facing the school) parking lot and enter through the AUDITORIUM doors.

Our summer band camp is where most of the information, playing, rehearsal, etc. is set for the entire year. Attendance at this camp will help your student begin their amazing musical journey for the 2023-2024 school year. As always, if you have any questions feel free to reach out to us!
