**What time is it? KNIGHT TIME!** This week's football game is Friday 9/6 at 7:00 PM at Challenger Stadium, 1955 W Nasa Blvd. The spirit theme is "Proud to be an American" Wear red, white & blue.

## Here's the game plan:

### At the High School (3:00-5:00 PM)

- 3:00 PM, **Prop & Roadie Crew** will meet in the high school parking lot. The driver of the 18-wheeler will stage the truck.
- 3:00 PM **Meal & Water committees** will meet in the hallway outside of the band hall to set up for dinner
- 3:30 PM, we will begin loading the equipment trailers as the band comes off the practice field. Some of the props may need to be loaded into the equipment trailer after all of the band equipment is loaded.
- 3:45-4 PM **Meal & Water Committees** will serve dinner & water
- 4:30 PM **Drivers** hauling the equipment trailers will load up & discuss travel plan
- 4:45 PM **Chaperones** meet at the band hall
- 5:00 PM The school buses with students will depart
- 5:00 PM The equipment trucks will depart the school headed to Hall Stadium in Missouri City, we will leave earlier if possible.

### At the Stadium( 5:30 PM -10:00 PM)

- 5:30 PM **Prop & Roadies** meet at the stadium to unload and stage props and equipment. As students arrive they will unload their instruments and equipment
- 7:00 PM Kick Off
- Half-time performance. **Prop & Roadies** meet on the sideline with about 2 minutes remaining in the 2nd Qtr. We will line up for the show
- **Half time announcer** will head to the Home press box
- The band will perform for the Emeralds, The Pit can be set up during the performance, but props will wait until they are off the field
- **Spirit Committee** will shout "Hey Band What time is it?" Immediately before they perform. The parents should answer, "Knight time!"
- **The Water & Washcloth committees** will stage water & washcloths so students can grab them after their performance and collect trash and wash clothes when finished.
- Directly following the show, **Prop & Roadies**, along with students, will load all props and most of the band equipment into the trailers
- After the game, **Props & Roadies**, along with students will load the reaming equipment and instruments
- **Chaperones** will meet back at the student buses and ride back with students

### At The HS (10:00 PM Approximately)

- Lastly, the **Prop & Roadie Crew** will meet back at the school to unload.
